GENERAL POLICY ON THE PRODUCTION, RELEASE AND DISSEMINATION OF MICRODATA

Objective

To serve as a guide for agencies in producing and releasing microdata taking into consideration confidentiality, user-friendliness, accessibility and timeliness

1. Production of Microdata

- 1.1 In compliance with NSCB Resolution No. 10 s. 1997 Adoption and Implementation of the Government Statistics Accessibility Program, government agencies engaged in the provision of statistical information shall produce microdata
- 1.2 Statistical activities covered by the System of Designated Statistics shall be given priority in producing microdata
- 1.3 Appropriate anonymization principles and practices shall be adopted to ensure confidentiality of respondents
- 1.4 Codebook/metadata/documentation/data dictionary shall be produced
- 1.5 Microdata Review Panel/s (MDRP) shall be created within the PUF-producing agency to review metadata prior to release

2. Release and Utilization of Microdata

- 2.1 Shall be used for statistical purposes only¹
- 2.2 Shall be used solely for reporting of aggregated information, and not for investigation of specific individuals or organizations (e.g., not for administrative, proprietary or legal purposes)
- 2.3 No attempt shall be made to re identify respondents nor publish individual records
- 2.4 No use shall be made of the identity of any respondent discovered inadvertently. Any such discovery shall immediately be reported to the producing agency
- 2.5 No attempt shall be made to produce links or matching among datasets, that will lead to the re-identification of respondents
- 2.6 Agencies shall make public and transparent the procedures for access as well as the availability, uses, target users and price of microdata they produce

3. Dissemination of Microdata

- 3.1 Shall be released in commonly used formats (e.g. SPSS, STATA, CSPRO, ASCII)
- 3.2 Shall be made available in various modes and channels of dissemination (e.g., CD-ROM, Internet)
- 3.3 Shall be available both in full or customized versions, if applicable
- 3.4 Charges/Prices shall be in accordance with the PSS pricing policy (NSCB Res. Nos. 11-1999 and 01-2006)
- 3.5 Provision to users shall be bound by a duly signed Terms of Use (TOU)
- 3.6 PUFs shall be released within 6-12 months after the release of final data from the surveys/censuses
- 3.7 Producing agencies shall include information on dissemination of microdata as part of their Advance Release Calendar
